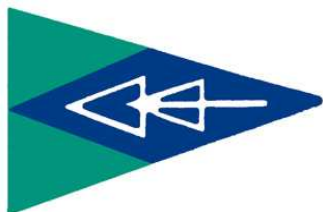


Bradwell Quay Yacht Club

Bradwell Quay offers an excellent location from which to start a cruise across the north sea to our neighbours in Holland, Belgium and France.



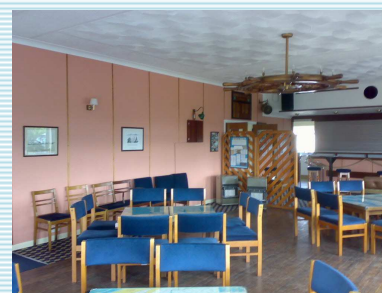
The Club House is located adjacent to the old historic Quay at Bradwell Waterside, positioned conveniently at the top of the slip that provides access to the moorings of Bradwell Creek.



With good access for Dinghies or Tenders and adequate storage facilities for visitors boats on the slip or in the dingy park, Bradwell Quay makes an ideal destination for that day cruise on the river.

Cruising yachts have the choice of the excellent marina, perhaps anchoring off the beach or picking up a mooring in the creek. The Club House can be reached at all states of the tide by either tender or a short walk along the sea wall.

Open every Saturday evening in the season for casual visitors, when you're welcome to make use of all the club facilities, including the self catering galley and excellent BBQ area with balcony & benches overlooking the creek.
